

Clermont County Department of Job and Family Services Summer Youth Employment Program



Clermont County DJFS is pleased to announce an employment opportunity for youth ages 16-24. The program will run from June, 2012 through August 31, 2012. An eligible youth will reside in a home whose income is less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. OWF and Food Assistance recipients are income eligible for this program.

Applications will be completed at a group orientation at Workforce One of Clermont County located at 756 Old State Route 74-Suite A, Cincinnati, OH. 45245, on June 8th at 10:00 AM. Applicants may be required to complete a job interview with employers.

Qualifications are simple; A participant must

- Be a youth ages 16-18 who is a full time student, **or**
- A youth ages 18-24 residing in the household with a minor child, **or**
- A youth ages 18-24 that has a minor child of their own
- Be willing to work 24 – 40 hours per week.
- Provide three written references from a teacher, community member, friend /neighbor or previous employer – no minors or relatives may be a reference
- If in high school or college, provide the most recent report card
- Be able to obtain transportation to and from employment. (Agency ***may*** provide CTC bus passes or mileage reimbursement.)
- May earn up to \$10 per hour!!
